



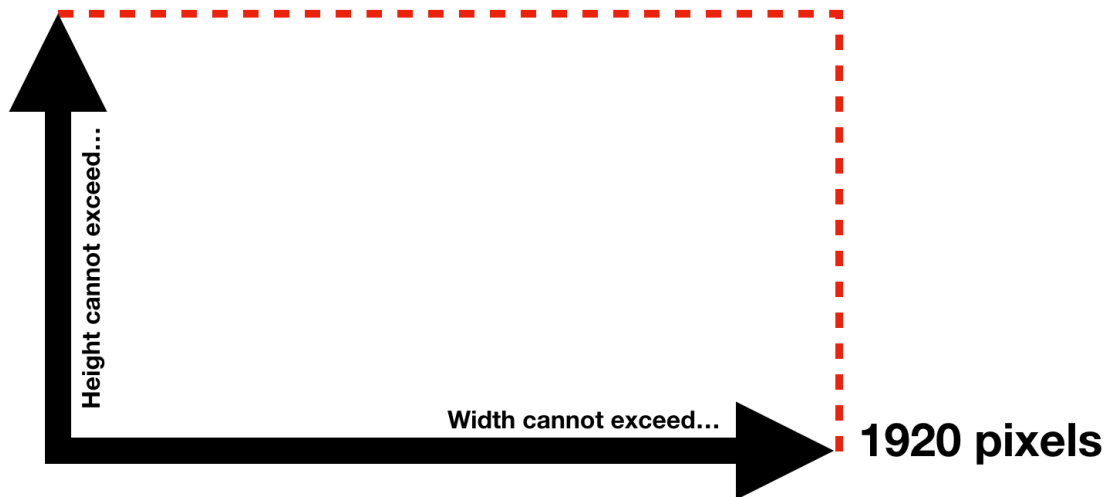
Competition Entry Sizes

In the interests of consistency, most photo clubs in SA, Australia and Internationally, insist on a specific size for all competition entries. Historically this has increased in dimension as data projectors have continued to improve in quality.

We use the same size the **SAPF** uses for its **Annual Competition** 1080 x 1920 pixels.

IMAGE Dimensions

1080 pixels



Keep **one** side or the **other** side at the **maximum**
So an image could be **1080x1400**, or **900x1920**

So, what this means is your image needs to fit **inside** the box. It doesn't matter in the slightest if one side is smaller, but you **MUST** at least have one side the correct measurement. If not, you are denying your image the chance to be seen in all its glory. It may not look as sharp as it could, or may simply be rather small.

A **panorama** might not be 1080 pixels high. This doesn't matter.

A **portrait** might not be 1920 pixels wide. This doesn't matter.

So, when you resize in your favourite editing program look carefully at what is happening.
